General Terms and Conditions

1. ARCreate

- 1.1 ARCreate is organized by the Mindfire Foundation, c/o Sielva Management AG, Gubelstrasse 11, 6300 Zug, Switzerland (CHE-142.155.301), further referred to as “the organizer”. The Mindfire Foundation (“Mindfire”) is a Switzerland-based not-for-profit organization dedicated to further progress in Artificial Intelligence research. Participation in the selection process, competition, or its events is free of charge for all participants.
- 1.2 Project office is operated via Lab42, welcome@lab42.global, Obere Straße 22B, 7270 Davos, Switzerland
- 1.3 The goal of ARCreate is to create a new test set for the Abstraction and Reasoning Corpus (ARC 2). ARC 2 is an ambitious extension of ARC that aims to address certain weak points of ARC 1.
- 1.4 ARCreate invites people from all over the world to create their own tasks and submit them for the ARC 2 task set. Lab42 will evaluate all submissions and create the final ARC 2 test set. By submitting, participants agree that their tasks can become part of the ARC 2 task set and that they will submit them under the Apache 2 license (<https://opensource.org/licenses/Apache-2.0>).
- 1.5 The ARCreate Webapp is available under <https://arc-editor.lab42.global/>.

2. Prizes and selection process

- 2.1 Among all participants who submit tasks until October 31, 2022, the organizer offers 1x 500 CHF and 5x 100 CHF. Each submitted and accepted task counts as a raffle ticket with a chance to win. The acceptance of a task is determined by Lab42 and requires for example that the task is solvable, has exactly one solution, and relies only on core knowledge. Lab42 will determine the winners in a blind process, where each accepted submission has the same likelihood of winning. Winners will be informed by email to the mail address they used upon registration. If the winners do not claim their money within 6 weeks, the award is forfeit.
- 2.2 Participants are not entitled to compensation for expenses of any kind.

3. Data Protection and liability disclaimer

- 3.1 Participants grant the organizer the right to process their submitted data.
- 3.2 All Mindfire employees, named representatives, members of the organizing office, mentors, judges, experts at events, advisory board members and other persons involved in the competition who have access to confidential participant or business case-related data undertake to maintain confidentiality vis-à-vis the participants by means of a confidentiality declaration.
- 3.3 No participant or other data may be published or disclosed without the consent of the participants, except for the information intended for publication, e.g. the ARC task itself.
- 3.4 The organizer and the jury members disclaim any liability for damages of any kind, in particular for damages caused by employees or auxiliary persons, in accordance with the provisions of Articles 100 and 101 of the Swiss Code of Obligations.
- 3.5 The organizer and Mindfire Foundation are not liable for the possible misuse of user data by third parties.
- 3.6 By registering, participants agree to receive occasional updates about Lab42 and its challenges. Participants may unsubscribe from the email newsletter at any time.

4. Ownership in IP and right to publish

- 4.1 Upon registration as a team participating in any of the Lab42 challenges (e.g. ARCathon, ARCreate) and accepting the participation terms, each participant grants to the Mindfire Foundation an unlimited, non-exclusive, sub-licensable, transferable, perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free, and fully paid-up license to safeguard, publish and further develop any submission and creation.
- 4.2 Mindfire maintains the right to publish and share any results at any given time and in accordance with Mindfire’s foundation purpose and regulations. Mindfire treats all results with the utmost care and respect and seeks whenever and however possible consent of the respective IP owner before any publication.

5. Limitation of Liability

- 5.1 The organizer reserves the right to cancel, modify or suspend ARCreate or any subsequent edition, or to change these conditions without prior notice or obligation, in case of an accident, printing, administrative or other error of any kind or any other reason.
- 5.2 In the event of any inconsistency or contradiction between these Terms and Conditions and any statements or other representations in the ARCreate materials, these Terms and Conditions shall prevail and apply to the fullest extent permitted by law. If for any reason, in the sole discretion of the

organizer, an ARCreate edition cannot proceed as originally contemplated in these Terms and Conditions, or if the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Contest is disrupted or impaired, including due to tampering, fraud or other causes beyond the control of the organizer, the organizer reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify, amend, extend or suspend the contest, in whole or in part, at any time and without notice. Subject to applicable law and any necessary regulatory approvals, the organizer reserves the right to change the dates and/or deadlines specified in these Terms and Conditions without prior notice, to the extent necessary to verify compliance by applicants with these Terms and Conditions, or due to other problems or circumstances that, in the organizer's opinion, affect the proper conduct of the Contest as defined in these Terms and Conditions, or for any other reason.

- 5.3 The organizer reserves the right to exclude from this contest and any future award programs or other promotions conducted by the organizer any person who, in its opinion, tampers with the entry process or the operation of ARCreate or violates these Terms and Conditions on any site, engages in unsportsmanlike or disruptive conduct or harasses, abuses, threatens, or bullies any other entrant.
- 5.4 Any attempt by an applicant or any other person to undermine the lawful operation of ARCreate or any Lab42 or Mindfire-affiliated website or sub-project is a violation of criminal and civil laws. Should such an attempt be made, the host and all affiliated employees and partners reserve the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law.
